This is a fun/social mixed Summer Football Season where Children & Adults can carry on Football over the Summer in a fun social environment.

#### Key Dates:

The Season will start on Thursday 24th October then skip 31st October (Halloween) and resume on 7th November until 12th December 2024 at MetroPark.

#### Times:

Juniors 9/10th grade & 11/12th grade teams

4-5.30pm - (2 games of 15 minutes each way) TBC depending on how many teams register

Youth (13th grade up) & Senior teams

6.30pm-8pm - (2 games of 15 minutes each way) TBC depending on how many teams register

#### Format rules:

- 7 a-side with a maximum of 10 players per team.
- Teams playing first to setup their field & those playing last to pack up.
- 15 minute halves ( 1 or 2 games depending). Straight turn around.
- Each team will provide a Referee to Ref one half of their game.
- Normal throw ins, free kicks and football rules apply with some exceptions

NO Offsides, back passes to keeper allowed.

#### Team Information:

- There will be 3 segmented divisions. 9&10, 11&12 and Youth/Senior.
- You must register a TEAM and payment will be charged per team, not individually.
- You will need a manager for your team
- Your team must have an identical shirt colour or bibs may be provided if there is a clash.
- Youth & Senior grades can be an all Youth team, all Senior team or a mix of Youth & Senior (These teams will play each other due to numbers)
